Your PowerPoint project must contain at least 10 slides and include:

- a title slide
- table of contents slide
- a bibliography slide that cites your sources
- pictures that support your details

Internet Sites you used:

Your research must include the following:

- Brief History (5 - 10 sentence description of the major highlights of your country's history)
- Biography of Current Leader (bullet point outline of the current leader of your country)
Details must include:
 - How he or she became the leader
 - Length of leadership
 - Political and/or military experience
 - Education
 - Family information
- Geography
Details must include:
 - Map of country
 - Description of geographical location
- Culture
Details must include:
 - Flag (bullet point description of the importance of the symbols and colors that are represented on the flag)
 - Important cultural characteristics of your country such as the language, currency, ethnic groups, etc.
 - Sample of music or art that is a part of your country's past or present
- Events (historical, cultural, and current events that are important in the development of your country)
Details must include:
 - 1 historical event that affected your country's national growth
 - 1 cultural event that helps define your country's national character
 - 1 current event (after 2000) that helps us understand your country's role in our global community
- Email
Details must include:
 - Sample email that you are willing to send to your country's consulate requesting information
 - Introduce yourself
 - Explain the assignment
 - Request information (for example... "What would you like a young person from the United States to know about your country?")
 - Thank the person for his or her assistance
